However, a user reports an issue about logging on to the published desktop. The user receives an error message stating that the evaluation license is about to expire. What should the administrator do to fix this issue?

NO.6 Scenario: A Citrix Administrator is enabling TLS Secure connections between the Cloud Connectors and on-premises StoreFront. After configuring the TLS certificate on all Cloud Connectors and disabling HTTP connections, the administrator finds that no resources are being enumerated. Which extra step does the administrator need to take to allow enumeration to work between on-premises StoreFront and Citrix Cloud?

- A. Configure Internet Information Services (IIS) on the StoreFront server to use HTTPS.
- B. Change transport type to HTTPS in the StoreFront store DDC list.
